The Flipped Classroom: An Introduction

What is this course about?

Flipped classrooms offer educators the opportunity to teach academic information to students while they are at home through video, reading and other resources, and then to practice the concepts in the classroom that were introduced at home. In this course, participants will study the science behind flipped classrooms, learn about gaining approval from administrators to use this method, the benefits and challenges of flipped learning, how to get parents involved in the day-to-day management of the process, and how to help your students transition from traditional learning to flipped learning. The minimum time for participant completion of this course is 30 hours over at least three days. Participants must be logged in to the course for 300 minutes over three days to receive credit for this course. The minimum time for participant completion of this course is at least 30 hours over at least three calendar days (4320 minutes or 72 hours). It is suggested that you use this syllabus to seek prior approval from your individual licensing agency BEFORE registering for this course.
